Pre-treatment seedpotatoes and the planting

- Lady Rosetta has got a short dormancy, pre-sprout them till to release the sprouts.
- Plant the seeds at groundlevel.
- Plant the seeds in the soil more warmer then 10°C, with a good structure.
- Soil or tubertreatment against silver scurf and *Rhizoctonia* is recommended.

Plant spacing

*On heavy soils use the smallest plant spacing.

Fertilizing (including the soilsupply)

Mg, Mn, Ca, Bo		Give these micro elements, if necessary, as a liquid fertilizer. They are stimulating the growth and have a positive effect on the quality.

Cultivation

- Lady Rosetta emergence quickly and has got a good foliagecoverage.
- The variety is little sensitive to the use of Sencorex (Metribuzin).
- Start quickly with late blight treatments, the variety is in the foliage very susceptible and the tubers susceptible.

Haulm killing, harvest and storage

- Make sure that there is enough time between haulm killing and harvest, look at the foliage maturity.
- Lady Rosetta is moderate sensitive to mechanical damage and very sensitive to bruising. A high UWW combined with cold conditions during harvest and storing are increasing bruising. Avoid during harvest and storing low temperatures as much as possible and keep drop heights as small as possible.
- It is possible to deliver the potatoes directly from the field to the factory.
- Provide rapid drying to prevent silver scurf (if necessary use heaters). Take good care for curing!
- After curing and drying, slowly drop the temperature to 8°C. Prevent condensation in the top layer. After drying the variety can be stored for around 4 month at 8°C.
